Petitioner is aggrieved by an order dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P2), vide which he was transferred from Government ITI, Loharu (Bhiwani) to Government ITI, Hansi (Hissar). Records show that this Court had issued notice to the respondents on 27.06.2017, but no interim order was granted. More than a year and a half has gone by. Concededly, in compliance to the transfer order the petitioner has since joined at Hansi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had stayed at Bhiwani for merely two years when he was transferred to Hansi. Further, he has old and aged parents, and a family to look after.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would submit a comprehensive representation in this regard to the respondents, and let the petition be disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in the event any such representation is made, the same shall be decided within a specified time.

In response, learned State counsel submits that in the event any such representation is made, the same shall be considered and dealt with within two months of the receipt of said representation. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.
