JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to re-fix/revise his pension @ ₹25,460/- per month w.e.f. May 01, 2006 along-with all other consequential and attended benefits including payment of arrears of pension or in the alternative to grant pension equal to the pension being paid to Sh. J.R. Verma (PPO No. 14105/HVPNL) being junior to him and getting higher pension of ₹26,640/- along-with all other consequential and attended benefits along-with payment of arrears of pension along-with an interest @18% per annum.

2. At the very outset of arguments, it has been emerged that during the pendency of instant petition, Finance Department of Haryana has issued a

clarification/instruction bearing NO. O.M. No. 2/14/2009/1 Pension, dated September 18, 2016 for the implementation of Revised Pension Rules (Part-II) 2009 and clarification has been given. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in case the afore-said instructions are implemented and the pension of the petitioner is revised, he would feel satisfied.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in the light of afore-said instructions and if the authority finds entitled to the petitioner to the relief claimed through the instant petition, to revise his pension and calculate the arrears and make the payment thereof, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In case of non-compliance of this order, petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
