The petitioners are JBT Teachers appointed on regular basis. Their grievance is that as per the policy of the Government, they are entitled to be posted to their home districts, but the Government is unable to do so as in the home districts regular posts are being occupied by contractual employees. As per law, the petitioners are entitled to be transferred to their home districts to occupy the existing posts and the Guest Faculty has to be relieved. Reliance is placed upon judgment dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed in CWP-17240-2016 titled as 'Anand Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others'. A representation dated 15.12.2017 (Annexure P-6) has been made, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let six copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order

thereupon, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
