The grievance of the petitioner-bank in the instant case is that it has taken measures under the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 against respondent No.3-borrower and in furtherance thereof, filed a petition under Section 14 of the 2002 Act before the District Magistrate, Jind. The said petition was listed for hearing on 11.04.2018 and order was kept reserved. It is alleged that the said order has not been pronounced till date due to which the petitioner-bank is unable to take further lawful action against the borrower.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on merits, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the District Magistrate, Jind to decide the above-mentioned petition filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
