Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are working as Accountants in various Market Committees in the State of Haryana. Twenty Four posts of Assistant Secretary have fallen vacant. As per rules of the year 2008 amended till date, 15% reservation is provided to the Accountants. Out of 24 posts, 16 have been filled up vide order dated 31.03.2018 by promoting Mandi Supervisors only. The Accountants are not being considered.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to ask for a written statement. For the same reason, private respondents need not be served.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the Chief Administrator of respondent No. 3, to consider this writ petition as representation and pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The speaking order will specifically deal with 15%

quota provided to the Accountants for the promotional post of Assistant Secretary.

Till the passing of the speaking order the respondents are restrained from filling up unfilled posts existing as on date.
