Petitioner confines his prayer to the decision of the appeal which is pending since 25.08.2017.

He had participated in an auction for allotment of booths successfully and deposited some amount pursuant thereof in terms of the requirement. Subsequently, he surrendered the booth and asked for a refund which was denied. It is against this denial that the appeal has been filed.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case and looking at the limited prayer made before us, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present appeal with a direction to the appellate authority to consider the appeal of the petitioner and decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of four months from the date
