JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature mandamus, directing the respondents for counting the period of daily wages work charge services from March, 1980 to 08.01.1993 followed by regular service for granting pensionary benefit and further to extent the benefit as granted in respect of similarly situated persons while deciding Civil Appeal No. 1772 of 2009.

2. During the course of arguments, it has emerged that the case of the petitioner was considered in the light of the record available with the respondents and his service from September 1985 up to the date of his

retirement was taken into consideration towards the qualifying service and a cheque bearing No.572497, dated 08.04.2016 was also handed over to the petitioner in the Court on 11.04.2016.

3. The parties are unable to bring on record the documents that the petitioner also served the department as a daily wage worker from March 1980 to September 1985. Since, the major relief has already been granted to the petitioner by the respondents, the instant petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court, in case, he intends to establish that he served the department from March 1980 to September 1985 also, but within a reasonable period.
