The petitioners are working as Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar in Gurugram. They were engaged during the period 1992-2001 on daily-wage/part-time basis. The Government issued notifications from 1992-2001 directing regularization of the services of such persons, who have completed six years of service. Pursuant thereto, juniors were regularized. Services of the petitioners have also been regularized but from a later date.

To correct this anomaly, legal notice dated 22.01.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been sent, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion. Mr. Hitesh Pandit, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the legal notice (Annexure P-5) and to pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
