The petitioners were appointed *Malis* on daily wages. Their services were regularised in between. Employees identically situated as the petitioners, have been granted certain emoluments but the petitioners have not been considered for the same. Their grievance is that the same emoluments should be granted to them as well with effect from the date their compatriots have been given the benefits.

The petitioners have come to this court for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus but demand notice has not been issued.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to treat this writ petition as a representation and pass a speaking order thereupon within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
