The petitioner has multiple grievances against HUDA authorities including levy of interest @18% per month besides additional interest and demand for enhanced compensation etc. In this regard the petitioner has sought some information from HUDA authorities vide representations dated 20.10.2015, 07.01.2016 and 30.10.2017. It is stated that though the requisite information was not supplied, nevertheless, the petitioner has made comprehensive representations dated 20.10.2015, 7.1.2016 and 30.10.2017 for redressal of his grievances. It is alleged that his representations have not been considered till date.

In view of the afore-stated stand taken by the petitioner but without expressing any views on merits of his claim, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 5 to ascertain the correct facts and decide the above-mentioned representations of the petitioner by way of a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
