The petitioners are aggrieved of the merger of two Panchayats and have alleged that the resolution passed by the Panchayat is improper.

We are of the opinion that if the resolution is improper, the petitioners would be at liberty to approach the Block Development and Panchayat Officer concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that they have already approached the Block Development and Panchayat Officer by making representations in this regard and would also like to submit a more comprehensive and detailed representation.

We accept the prayer of the petitioners to submit another detailed representation on the line of the present petition within a period of two weeks from today and thereafter the respondent No.2 would look into the grievance of the petitioners and take a decision on the representation by passing a speaking order and giving an

opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed of.
