Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to pay compensation for demolition of the boundary wall of his premises in a illegal manner and further to allow him to reconstruct the same. It has been urged before this court that wall in question was demolished by the GMADA authority without assigning any reason or affording any opportunity. According to learned counsel, said wall is existed on the land of the petitioner as it is clear from the photographs Annexure P/3.

I am of the considered view that plea raised by the petitioner is purely factual in nature and can not be adjudicated upon in the writ jurisdiction. As regards prayer for damages, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek appropriate remedy.
