The petitioners seeks regularization in terms of the policy/scheme of regularization of daily wage workers prevalent in departments of the Chandigarh Administration. Legal Notice dated 26.12.2017 (Annexure P-6) has been issued to the respondents but no relief has been provided to the petitioners.

In view of the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2, to objectively consider the Legal Notice dated 26.12.2017 (Annexure P-6) and pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case an order is passed in favour of the petitioners consequential benefits shall be paid to them in further period of four weeks.
