1. The petitioner has approached this Court for a direction to the respondents-Central Board of Secondary Education to correct her father's name from "Banbari Lal to "Banwari Lal" in the class 10th Certificates.

2. To support her case, the petitioner annexed copies of Ration Card, Voter I-Card and Aadhar Card wherein her father's name is mentioned as "Banwari Lal".

3. Today, CM No.13783 of 2018 for placing on record affidavit of Banwari Lal, father of the petitioner is also listed for hearing. In the affidavit, father of the petitioner has stated that that there is no criminal or civil liability against him and he will not take any undue benefit in case correction is allowed.

4. In view of the above, CM for placing on record the affidavit and this petition are allowed. The respondent-CBSE is directed to issue fresh certificates in respect of Secondary School Examination (10th) to the petitioner after correcting her father's name from "Banbari Lal to "Banwari Lal". The fresh certificates be delivered upon return of old

certificates to the CBSE. The necessary exercise be completed within fortnight from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. Needless to say that the CBSE while issuing fresh/corrected educational certificates will record in the certificates that '*the correction in respect of the father's name is as per orders of the Punjab & Haryana High Court in CWP No.14418 of 2017*'.
