Pursuant to the order dated 8.2.2018, the respondent/State has
filed the compliance report submitted by the Deputy Commissioner,
Kurukshetra dated 26.2.2018 today in Court and the same is taken on record.

Paras No.3 & 4 of the said report read as under: -

*“3. That in compliance with the
directions issued by this Hon’ble Court vide
order dated 8.2.2018, the undersigned
convened a meeting in her office on
12.2.2018 and all the persons concerned i.e.
the agriculturists of village Ishakpur,
District Kurukshetra were present in the
said meeting. Besides this, the officers of
the concerned Department also participated*

in the said meeting. The grievance of concerned persons were heard and after holding discussions with them, it was felt necessary to construct the Culverts beneath the road leading from Ishakpur to Shadipur Nawaba situated in between the land of the agriculturists concerned of village Ishakpur, for proper and smooth discharge of the rainy water to avoid any kind of loss to the crops of the agriculturists. Therefore, with the consent of all agriculturists, it was unanimously decided to construct the Culverts for proper discharge for rainy water in its natural flow.

4. That pursuant to the aforesaid, unanimous decision is taken in the meeting dated 12.2.2018, four Hume Pipe Culverts at RD (KM) 7050, 7350, 7400 & 7700, have been constructed/laid in between the fields of the agriculturists of village Ishakpur for proper and smooth discharge of the rainy water in its natural flow and with the construction the above said Hume Pipe Culverts, the dispute stands resolved and the grievance of all the persons

*concerned has been redressed. Now there
is no grievance of any of the agriculturists.”*

There is an application also bearing CM No.2900 of 2018 filed by the applicants/respondents No.6 to 11.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and taken into consideration the facts and circumstances, CM No.2900 of 2018 is hereby dismissed and the writ petition is disposed of in terms of the status report submitted by the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra dated 26.2.2018.
