In the instant writ petition, petitioners have prayed for the following relief :-

"Issue an appropriate, writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the salary/emoluments to the petitioners under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, from the date of their initial joining, by implementing policy instructions, Annexure P1 to P8 in the case of the petitioners besides granting them other service benefits i.e. EPF, health services and insurance under the EPF & MP Act, 1952 as stipulated in para No.3 of the policy instructions dated 10.08.2016, Annexure P-1 as the

petitioners are being discriminated in the matter of implementation of these policy instructions, Annexure P1 to P8 in flagrant violation of Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India without any rhyme, reason and justification, contrary to law;"

2. The respondent-Director, Department of Industrial Training Haryana passed a speaking order to what extent the petitioners are entitled to relief in terms of the relief sought in the present petition on 27.02.2018. In view of the fact that petitioner's grievance is only writ of mandamus and respondents have passed a speaking order, present petition do not survive for consideration. Accordingly, CWP stands disposed of. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to challenge the speaking order dated 27.02.2018 if the same is not in accordance with law.
