The petitioner has challenged the order/award of the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), SAS Nagar, Mohali [for short 'the PLA'] dated 24.10.2017 by which application filed by him under Section 22-C of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 [for short 'the Act'] has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the house loan obtained by him was in the name of individual and in this regard he has referred to Annexure P-3 but he could not deny the findings recorded by the PLA in para Nos. 11 to 13 in which after taking into consideration various documents on record, it has been opined that the loan was not individual.

Thus, in view of the aforesaid, there is hardly any scope for interference in the impugned order/award and hence the present petition is hereby dismissed. No costs.
