The grievance of the petitioners is that the persons appointed after them have been retained in service whereas they have been relieved from their services. Posts are still lying vacant. Representation dated 29.3.2018 (Annexure P-6) has been submitted by them in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

In view of the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to call for written statement.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 29.3.2018 (Annexure P-6) and pass a speaking order thereupon within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
