In the present petition, the petitioner is praying that the work charge service rendered by her deceased husband with the respondents should be taken into account for calculating the pensionary benefits.

As per the averments made in the petition, husband of the petitioner started working with respondents from the year 1969 and he continued to work on work charge basis till May 1980, when he was regularly appointed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been prayed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 20.05.2015 (Annexure P-3) which is still under consideration.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that a speaking order

shall be passed within a period of three months from today deciding the legal notice considering all the pleas raised by the petitioner therein.

In view of the above said statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 20.05.2015 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to her within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
