The petitioner had applied for the post of Heavy Vehicle Driver. He failed in the Driving Proficiency Test. Thereafter, he approached this Court and it was directed that on deposit of a sum of ₹ 5000/-, the petitioner shall be shown videography and would be permitted to raise objections. The petitioner has been shown the videography and was permitted to raise objections. Vide the order dated 23.04.2018, his objections have been considered and rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to show that the said order is perverse so as to enable this Court to exercise to exercise certiorari jurisdiction.

In this view of the matter, the petition has no merit and is accordingly, dismissed.
