The loan amount of Rs.3.00 lacs taken from the respondent-bank by the petitioner's son is sought to be repaid by the petitioner. It is alleged that statement of account has not been supplied by the respondent-bank due to which he could not settle the loan account.

The writ petition, at this stage, is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents who in turn are directed to supply the statement of loan account of the petitioner's son. The petitioner thereafter may approach the bank for 'One Time Settlement' within one week and his request may be considered by the bank sympathetically.
