This petition is filed by the petitioner under Section 3 (1) (d) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for seeking his premature release on parole for four weeks for the purpose of facilitating the admission of his son in the 12th standard.

In brief, the petitioner is suffering 15 years' sentence in a case registered under the NDPS Act, 1985 and is presently lodged in the District Jail, Faridabad. It is submitted that from the last 4½ years, the petitioner is in prison and has not availed any benefit of parole or furlough. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case except the one in which he has been convicted and sentenced.

In the reply, the respondents have attached the police verification report (Annexure R-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the name of the son of the petitioner is Vinod who is to be admitted in Balaji Public School, Adarsh Nagar, Ballabgarh, Faridabad and in this regard, he has appended the certificate issued by the School which is annexed as Annexure P-2.

Since, the petitioner is basically a native of Tamil Nadu, therefore, while allowing him two weeks of parole, the District Magistrate

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concerned, who is to take the bail bonds of the petitioner, is directed to ensure that the petitioner do not flee from justice or try to abscond on being parole and hence, appropriate conditions may be imposed in the order of bail.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
