The petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking benefit of the revised pay scale along with arrears and also for release of the annual increment from 11.03.1998 to 21.09.2012 and also the other retiral benefits for which her late husband was entitled for.

Learned State counsel states that all the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for, have been released during the pendency of the writ petition, which statement is accepted by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even though the benefits have been released but the interest has not been paid on the delayed payments made to the petitioner. He seeks permission of this Court to file a representation to the respondents for the said claim of interest.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation seeking interest on the

payments released to her within a period of four weeks and in case any representation is filed by the petitioner within the stipulated time, the respondents shall pass a speaking order deciding the same within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of in above terms.
