The petitioners are working as Trainee Waiters. Their grievance is that they are being paid less salary on account of being shown as Group-D employees. In fact, they are technically qualified and should be included in the technical zone. If the said benefit is given to them, then they will fall in the category of Group-C employees and their pay would also be increased. A legal notice dated 09.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been served in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would feel satisfied in case, a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the aforementioned legal notice by passing a speaking order thereupon.

The request is reasonable and is accepted. The writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider the legal notice dated 09.02.2018 (Annexures P-5) and pass a speaking order thereupon within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
