By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for the issuance of a writ in the nature mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears of suspension period w.e.f. October 03, 1999 to June 16, 2003 and full pension from the due date along-with interest @12% per annum on the delayed payment and also to grant him all other consequential benefits.

2. Though, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner to assist this Court. However, it has been pointed out by learned State counsel that the matter with regard to the suspension period of the petitioner has already been dealt with and disposed of. The annual increments have been restored including the suspension period and an amount of ₹1,40,945/- accrued to the petitioner on account of the arrears accrued to him in pursuance of said

restoration of annual increments as well as suspension period has already been disbursed to the petitioner vide order dated June 23, 2015. Further pension case of the petitioner for revision of pensionary benefits has also been forwarded to respondent No.4 for approval on July 01, 2015.

3. In the afore-said facts and circumstances, the grievance of the petitioner stood redressed and instant petition has rendered infructuous and is disposed of, as such.

4. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available to him under law, if he still feels aggrieved with regard to the quantum of amount released in his favour or interest etc.
