In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the order dated 26.8.2015 (Annexure P-7) insofar replacement of CISF Personnel for security duties at Embassy of India, Kathmandu 7 Consulate General of India, Birgunj (Nepal). He has further sought for direction to consider his name for the aforesaid issue. On the preliminary ground itself, petition is not maintainable on the score that petitioner has failed to implead such of those persons whose names are reflected in Annexure P-7 dated 26.8.2015. Petitioner's representation has been considered and rejected vide Annexure R-1 dated 24.9.2015 which is placed on record along with the written statement. Representation of the petitioner was decided in the year 2015. Till date petitioner has not made any effort to challenge Annexure R-1 dated 24.09.2015. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case.

2. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. This order will not come in the way of petitioner's claim considering afresh provided, if he had necessary right under the statutory provision.
