The petitioner is working on the post of Mali. She is aggrieved by the fact that the juniors to her have been regularised, with effect from an early date than her date of regularization. A legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P-9) has been made in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon.

Mr. Hitesh Pandhit, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondent No.4, nor it is necessary to seek written statement.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2, to consider the legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (Annexures P-9) and pass a speaking order thereupon within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
