Through the instant civil writ petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 16.02.2014, Annexure P-10 passed by respondent No.3 vide which the representation moved by the petitioner for correction of date of his birth from 05.02.1960 to 10.04.1963 has been dismissed.

At the outset, it has been pointed out by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has sought correction in date of his birth and that such question of fact cannot be decided without leading evidence, therefore, the present writ petition is not maintainable.

On being asked, the learned counsel was unable to show any material to substantiate his plea that the date of birth of the petitioner is 10.04.1963.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the entry of date of birth cannot be changed without there being any basis and that to determine the factum of date of birth, evidence is required to be adduced, this Court feels that such exercise cannot be done in the present writ petition, therefore, the same is hereby dismissed.
