By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Lecturer from the date when her juniors have been promoted to the post of Lecturers, as she is senior to them, as such she is fully eligible and entitled for the same.

2. At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even though the petitioner served legal notice dated 09.03.2018 (P-5) upon the respondents but till date neither any response to the notice has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice (P-5) within a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on merit as well as in view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 09.03.2018 (P-5) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules and regulation, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case the petitioner feels aggrieved by any in-action of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to her under law including to approach this Court.
