This civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to promote the petitioners from the post of Road Roller Cleaner to the post of Supervisor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner restricts his claim to the extent of consideration under the amended rules, namely, the Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Group-C) (Second Amendment) Service Rules, 2018 published on 23.01.2018 within a specified time.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 3 states that

now, there is a provision for promotion from class IV to class III to the post of Supervisor from amongst Chowkidar, Road Roller and Cleaner.

In view of the admission, the respondents are directed to consider the claim of the petitioner for promotion under the new rules and on the analogy whereby respondent No.4 had been promoted. The needful be done within six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
