1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuing direction to respondent-Bank and District Magistrate not to take the physical possession of the mortgaged properties as the petitioners are ready and willing to pay the outstanding amount.

2. Learned counsel for the parties submitted that the petitioner has settled the loan account by clearing the loan and, therefore, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
