Petitioner has filed the writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India challenging the order dated 18.05.2016 (Annexure P-6) whereby the predecessor in interest Raghubir Singh father of the petitioner Satish had filed revision petition which was remanded by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana. In pursuance of that, the Assistant Commissioner 1st Grade, Nahar has passed the order dated 23.05.2017 (Annexure P-7).

Once the order has been passed in favour of the petitioner at his instance itself the maintainability of the writ petition itself is subject matter to which the counsel is at odds to explain. Faced with this situation, counsel prays to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy to challenge the subsequent proceedings, in accordance with law if permissible.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the said liberty.
