The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that she has been denied promotion to the post of Head Constable.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the marks for service record given to the petitioner are very high, she has been given very low marks in the interview, so as to prevent her from being promoted. According to him, the candidature of the petitioner has not been objectively considered on account of malafides.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has, however, not been able to substantiate the allegation of malafides. No person, who may possess an animus against the petitioner has been named. Merely, making an allegation of malafides is not sufficient.

Thus, there is no merit in the writ petition and the same is dismissed.
