The petitioner is working as Principal in Government Senior Secondary School, Salehpur, District Yamuna Nagar. He was dismissed from service after conducting a Departmental Inquiry on the ground of being absent from duty as well as embezzlement. Subsequently, the petitioner was acquitted by the Criminal Court. Thereafter, a memorial was presented by the petitioner before the Hon'ble Governor of Haryana, whereupon another enquiry was conducted and enquiry report is dated 30.10.2017. The findings of the said enquiry report are that the charge of absence from duty was partially proved, whereas the charge of embezzlement was not proved. Despite the enquiry having been conducted wayback on 30.10.2017, no action has been taken thereupon by the Department. A legal notice dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-18) has been issued, yet no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be

supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction to Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Department of Education, to consider the legal notice dated 23.04.2018 (Annexures P-18) objectively and dispose of the same by passing a speaking order thereupon within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
