RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

The petition is disposed of with a direction that in the matter of promotion or reversion from the post of Superintendent, the ratio of 3:1 is to be maintained as provided by the Haryana Agricultural Directorate (Group B) Service Rules, 2003 (Annex P1). The petition has been filed on an apprehension that the petitioner will be reverted because he was promoted earlier in place of an employee who is facing disciplinary proceedings. The writ petition is pre-mature and based on apprehension the disposal of the petition at this stage would suffice since the cause of action has not arisen as no adverse order has been passed and impugned. If any violation of the ratio of 3:1 is done by the Department, the erring officers can always be held responsible by this Court and saddled with exemplary costs. In case an adverse order is passed ex facie contrary rules, the petitioner can approach Court.

With these observations the petition stands disposed of.
