This petition is directed against the order of the Lokpal (Ombudsman), Electricity, Punjab dated 25.01.2018. In the last paragraph of the order dated 25.01.2018, the Ombudsman has observed as under:-

“8. In case, the Petitioner or the Respondent (Licensee) is not satisfied with the above decision, they are at liberty to seek appropriate remedy against this order from the appropriate Bodies in accordance with Regulation 3.28 of Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Forum and Ombudsman) Regulations, 2016.”

In view of the above, since there is an alternate remedy available to the petitioner, the present petition is not maintainable and is dismissed as such. However, the petitioner may, if so advised, avail the alternate remedy available to it, in accordance with law.
