The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.3 to lease out the Shamlat land owned by respondent no.5 in favour of petitioners by granting them the benefit of reservation as prescribed under Rule 6 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Rules, 1964.

The solitary prayer made before us during the course of hearing is that the representations (Annexures P3 and P4) that the petitioners moved have not been decided by respondent no.3.

Therefore, without commenting on the merits of the controversy, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent no.3 to decide the representations (Annexure P3 and P4) of the petitioners forthwith.
