This petition is filed for seeking parole for a period of six weeks under Section 3(i)(c) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 (for short 'the Act'). The petitioner is a resident of village Naya Kunda Majra Bassi,, P.S.Gangoh, District Saharanpur (U.P.), who is now confined in District Jail, Karnal in a case registered vide FIR No.269 dated 15.5.2007 under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C at P.S.City Karnal. The petitioner is suffering sentence for a period of seven years and has also suffered the substantial sentence. He has prayed for his release on parole for agricultural purpose. His application is contested by the respondents on the ground that they have received communication from District Magistrate, Saharanpur that in case the petitioner is released on parole, then there would be a threat to the security of the State or the maintenance of public order. However, learned counsel for the State could not explain as to how the petitioner would be a danger to the security of the State when allegation against him is only of the counterfeit of currency. There is no other allegation against the petitioner as earlier also he has been released on parole.

In view thereof, the present petition is hereby allowed and the

petitioner is ordered to be released on parole for a period of four weeks subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Karnal, who would impose necessary conditions to ensure the surrender of the petitioner after the period of parole is over.
