The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that suspension allowance has not been paid to him, since the date of his suspension in the year 2015. A legal notice dated 11.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been issued in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforementioned legal notice by passing a speaking order thereupon with a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let six copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no need to seek written statement.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to objectively consider the legal notice dated 11.04.2018 (Annexure P-5), within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
