SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner is employed as a Conductor in the Haryana Roadways. He had sought his transfer from Delhi to Jind on account of personal reasons. His representation was accepted and he was transferred to his home station i.e. Jind. However, within a short-while thereafter, his transfer was cancelled and he was repatriated to Delhi. Thereafter, the petitioner has been again transferred to Chandigarh. This, according to the learned counsel for the petitioner is illegal and cannot not be sustained. A legal notice dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-6), has been sent in this regard, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion. Mr. Gaurav Jindal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana. Let six copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement, at this stage.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider legal notice dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-6) and to pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
