The petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 vide which the E-tender filed by the petitioner for outsourcing of support services for health institutions of District Sirsa, Health Department has been rejected.

2. During the bidding process, petitioner quoted rates @ ₹664824.41 and was L-1, whereas respondent No.6 who offered ₹667166.97 was declared successful to perform the work for outsourcing of support services for health institutions.

3. Learned counsel submitted that no cogent reasons have been assigned while rejecting the bid of the petitioner and accepting the offer of respondent No.06.

4. Counsel for the petitioner prayed that liberty be

granted to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation before the appropriate authority by incorporating the grievances as raised in the present writ petition and a direction be issued to the authority concerned to decide the representation expeditiously in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, perusing the present writ petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, we dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation, raising all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition before respondent No.2 i.e. Directorate of Information, Public Relation/Director General Health Services, Haryana, Sector-6, Panchkula, Haryana within a period of 05 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It is directed that in the event of a representation being filed by the petitioner within the aforesaid period, the same shall be decided by the said authority within next 10 days by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as respondent No.6 in accordance with law.
