The present petition has been filed for seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to not to allow respondent No.5 to do the work on higher rates than the rates given by the petitioner.

The writ petition is of the year 2015. The period of tender was for the crop year 2015-16 and the last date for the expiry of the tender was 31.3.2016. Learned counsel for respondent No.5 has submitted that since the said period has already expired, therefore, prayer made in the petition has become redundant.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner because the period for which tender was given, has already expired and with the efflux of time, the cause of action arisen in this case has also become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
