The earlier civil writ petition No.21730 of 2011 filed by the petitioners was admittedly allowed subject to certain conditions by this Court alongwith a bunch of writ petitions including CWP No.21572 of 2011 (Rohtas and others versus State of Haryana and others) decided on 04.09.2013 (P-1). The instant writ petition has been filed stating that in gross violation of the directions issued in the above-stated order, the respondent-authorities have started constructing the road and have not released the property. The petitioners have admittedly filed a contempt petition in which this Court issued show-cause notice for 04.10.2018 for the alleged non-compliance of above cited order.

In our considered view, once appropriate directions have been already issued by this Court, the second writ petition for the same relief would not be maintainable as the rightful remedy available to the petitioners has since been availed by them. If the authorities have violated this Court's directions, it is obvious that the law would take its own course.

Disposed of with liberty to pursue the contempt proceedings.
