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**ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners pray for a direction to the respondents to consider their respective claims for regularisation of their services, particularly when persons juniors to them have since been regularised. The petitioners are alleged to be engaged with the respondent department as Water Carriers/Cooks and had joined services between 1990 to 1999. A reference is made to a notification dated 7.7.2014, issued by the respondents, that postulates regularisation of services of similar employees.

In response, learned State counsel submits that although the petitioners are working with the respondent department in different capacities, but were engaged on part time basis. And before institution of the petition at hands, they never represented to the respondents or raised any demand to seek regularisation of their services. He submits that the respondents shall consider this petition as representation of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within three months from today.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned State counsel.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms. However, in the event, the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, and assigning reasons in support thereof.
