The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is a chronic diabetic and is also suffering from a Paralytic attack. Vide order dated 20.12.2017 (Annexure P-6), he was transferred on promotion from Jind to Hansi. On account of his medical condition, the petitioner had made a representation dated 02.02.2018 (Annexure P-7), but no action was taken thereupon, necessitating the filing of CWP-5195-2018, which was withdrawn vide order dated 07.03.2018 with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his representation aforementioned. The order of the writ petition was received by the respondents on 08.03.2018 and despite repeated requests of the petitioner, no order is being passed thereupon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement, at this stage.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to expeditiously consider the representation dated 2.2.2018 (Annexure P-7) and

to pass a speaking order thereupon in the light of prevailing transfer policy, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
