By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to consider and decide the pending claim of the petitioners especially legal notice dated 23.03.2018 (P-8) for re-fixation of pensionary benefits/pay along with arrears, by notionally promoting the petitioners with effect from the date of promotion of juniors, in terms of Punjab Government Decision dated 14.03.2017 (P-2) and for grant of consequential benefits in terms thereof.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though a legal notice dated 23.03.2018 (P-8) was moved to the respondents but till date, neither any reply to the afore-said notice has been received nor any
