Learned counsel for the petitioner points out to the zimni orders and states that notice was issued for 30.05.2018 and interim order of stay granted but on 16.05.2018 the order was vacated without offering any reason. Learned counsel for the present petitioner was not available and this was duly informed to the competent authority, yet the matter was proceeded with and the stay vacated. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that this has resulted in a serious prejudice to his cause.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and noticing the limited grievance that has been raised before us we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction that the competent authority shall decide the stay application by passing a speaking order after hearing the parties on the date fixed i.e. 30.05.2018 and till then the dispossession of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

Petition stands disposed of.
