Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that services of the petitioner have been wrongly terminated. At the time of his appointment vide endorsement dated 30.06.2004, the Licensing Authority, Agra had confirmed that the petitioner had been issued a licence by it and thereafter his licence had been renewed twice in the State of Haryana, yet, his services have been terminated on the ground that the driving licence produced by him at the time of appointment was fake. It is further submitted that an appeal dated 23.01.2017 (Annexure P-12) has been filed against the order of termination and no order has been passed thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let five copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written statement.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2, to expeditiously consider the appeal dated 23.01.2017 (Annexure P-12) and to dispose of the same in the light of law on the subject, within a period of four weeks from the

Date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Meanwhile, the order terminating the services of the petitioner shall remain stayed.
