JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner-Baljinder Singh was an aspirant for appointment to the post of 'Laboratory Technician' against the two (02) posts advertised in the Backward Class (ESM) Category on consolidated salary of ₹ 9,200/- (Ninety Two Hundred only) per month. On the basis of selection process, the petitioner was placed at Sr. No. 3 of the merit list in the said category and concededly, upon non-joining of Mr. Anil Kumar, who was placed at Sr. No. 2, the petitioner was entitled to be appointed against the said vacant post, which still is lying vacant. There is absolutely no justification for not offering the appointment to the petitioner against the advertised vacancy based on his merit.

placed on record appointment letter dated 23.01.2018 offering the petitioner appointment as Laboratory Technician on Contract Basis at a consolidated remuneration. Photocopy of the appointment letter is placed on record.

In view of the aforesaid subsequent development, counsel for the parties are agreed that the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
