Her grievance is that juniors have been regularized with effect from an earlier date, from which the petitioner has been regularized. Legal Notice dated 25.03.2018 (Annexure P-7) has been issued but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 4. Let five copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondents No. 5 and 6 at this stage, neither it is necessary to seek written statement.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2, to objectively consider the Legal Notice dated 25.03.2018 (Annexure P-7) and pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
